About our K-9 Team

The Richland County Sheriff's Department K-9 Unit is part of the Special Teams Division. The K-9 Unit currently has sixteen K9 teams.

The purpose of the K-9 Unit is to provide the citizens of Richland County with trained police service dogs to help locate illegal narcotics, apprehend fleeing felons, detect explosive devices and find lost/missing persons. To accomplish this, the unit utilizes thirteen police service dogs. At present the unit has 14 Belgian Malinois, 2 Dutch Shepherds. All of our dogs are dual purpose dogs, meaning they are trained in two or more of the following areas: narcotics, tracking, apprehension and/or explosives. Each dog has proven on numerous occasions to be an asset to the department and the community.

Each dog must be trained and certified in its particular duties. As officers must be continuously trained in law enforcement, so must police dogs. All of the training is conducted by the unit's handlers and trainer several times a week. Richland County has one of the most respected and successful K-9 Units in the state.
